A New Record of the Water Scorpion, Laccotrephes maculatus (Heteroptera, Nepidae) from Japan

Through the field research to the Ryukyus in April of 1992, we were able to collect some specimens of *Laccotrephes maculatus* (FABRICIUS, 1775) from Yonaguni Is. The tiny water scorpion is widely distributed in SE. Asia northward to Taiwan (FERRARI, 1888; SONAN, 1923), and is newly recorded from Japan (Ryukyus). Body length: 16–18 mm excluding respiratory siphon.
